A brighter future...

Thanks to a £50,000 grant from the VCSE Energy Efficiency Scheme, led by the Department for Culture, Media and Sport, we've been able to upgrade the lighting across all the Old School buildings to make our site more energy efficient and cost-effective. The work was carried out by an Aylesham company, One Call Electrical Services, in January and February.


